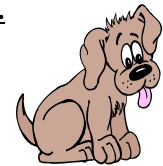
Animal licensing renewal and vaccination clinic

It's that time of year again! Our annual Rabies Vaccination clinic will be held on August 22nd, 2019 at the Levan Town hall (Ambulance Bay) from 5-7:00 pm. Gunnison Valley Animal Clinic will be here to administer vaccinations so please bring your

cats and dogs ages 6 months and older. (Please see the attached sheet for all vaccination prices). Please remember to keep all dogs and cats on a leash or in carrier boxes to ensure safety for animals and owners. Animal license renewal is also due by Sep-

tember 1st 2019 and can be renewed during the clinic. Animal licensing prices are \$10.00 for animals that are spayed/neutered and \$15.00 for animals not spayed/neutered. Those animals registered on or after

October 1st 2019 will be charged \$15.00 for spayed/neutered and \$22.50 for animals not spayed/neutered. **Remember that you will have to pay separately for licensing and vaccinations.**



Garbage day

Every Wednesday is garbage day in Levan. All residents please have your garbage can out to the edge of the street (**edge of the asphalt**) by 7 am Wednesday morning for pick up. If you do not put your garbage can out properly, it will not be picked up. After your

garbage has been picked up, please remove your garbage can off the street.

Please be aware that the garbage rate for one can is \$15.00. If you put out an additional can you will be charged an additional \$15.00. Remember that **ONLY HOUSEHOLD**

WASTE is allowed in the garbage. If you have tree limbs, grass clippings, leaves or weeds, please use the green dump. If your garbage contains anything other than household waste, **it will not be picked up**. If you need another garbage can please contact the Town Hall.

Call before you dig!

Levan Town is your Natural Gas distributor. As such, we operate our gas system with an emphasis on safety. We design, operate and maintain our underground natural gas pipeline system in accordance with federal safety standards.

It is the responsibility of the customer to maintain the gas piping downstream from the gas meter (for example, from the gas meter throughout the home or structure). If it is not properly maintained, it may corrode or leak. To insure the lines are safe and reliable, they should be

checked periodically. It is recommended that you contact a licensed plumber or heating contractor to assist you in downstream plumbing beyond the gas meter.

If any unsafe conditions are discovered, repair should be made as soon as possible. Levan Town Gas Department can refer you to licensed plumbing and heating contractors, or you can use the Yellow Pages for listings.

Should you plan to do any outside digging, Utah law requires that you contact Blue Stakes by calling 811 two days in advance. This is a free service that is used

to locate all underground utility services.

Please be advised that under state law if you do not call 811, you will be billed by all 3rd party entities that are required to be notified in the event of a gas line incident. You can be billed up to \$5,000.00 per party for damage prevention with a maximum civil penalty of \$100,000.00 per excavation. If an excavator fails to provide notice of an excavation, they may be fined an additional \$500.00 along with the previously listed penalties.

Green Dump

Just a reminder.....

We accept the following for disposal: Grass clippings, Leaves, Brush, Branches, Garden Vegetation, and weeds.

Levan Town PROHIBITS the dumping of the following items: Dirt, Animal carcasses, Concrete, Construction materials/scrap, Metal, Plastic, Brick, Stones, Rocks, Asphalt chunks, Garbage, Baby Diapers, old Toys, Furniture, etc.

Please remember that just because you think it is biodegradable does not mean it belongs in the green dump. We are lucky to have this

available to us.

IF WE ABUSE IT WE WILL LOSE IT!

For other items, please use the Juab County Landfill located west of Nephi. Operating hours (year around) Tuesday-Friday 9 am to 3:30 pm, Saturdays 8 am to 4 pm (except holiday weekends), closed Sundays, Mondays and Holidays. REMINDER

Animal licenses are due September 1, 2019. We will be holding a rabies vaccination clinic on August 22, 2019 from 5-7 pm at the Levan Town Hall. Please keep all dogs and cats on a leash or in carrier boxes to ensure safety for animals and owners. **Remember that you need to pay vaccinations separate from licensing.** We will be able to accept Check or cash.

For a spayed or neutered dog the license fee is \$10.00, and if unaltered the licensing fee is \$15.00 if paid by September 1, 2019. If paid after October 1, 2019 the fee increases by 50%.
